## General Directions

The library is located on the north side of Lake Street between Harlem and Oak Park Avenues.

- ◆ If using I-290 (Eisenhower expressway), exit north on either Harlem Avenue (Rt. 43) or Austin Boulevard and continue north to Lake Street (approx. 1.0 to 1.2 miles).
- ◆ Turn right off of Harlem or left off of Austin on to Lake Street.

NOTE 1: There is a Noodles & Co. on the SW corner of Harlem Ave. and Lake St. The intersection also has a stoplight. The library is about 0.5 miles east of Harlem Ave. on your left-hand side.

NOTE 2: There is a Mississippi Fish & Chicken on the NW corner of Austin Blvd. and Lake St. The library is less than 0.1 mile west of Oak Park Ave. or 1.1 miles west of Austin Blvd. on your right-hand side.

## Parking

A parking garage is located on the lower level of the library and is accessible from Lake Street. It is locked when the library closes.

### Garage Rates

2 hours or less: Free  
2-3 hours: \$1  
3-4 hours: \$5  
4-6 hours: \$10  
6-12 hours: \$20

The kiosk in the library's garage lobby accepts cash and credit cards.

Metered and unmetered off-the-street parking and other self-service/valet parking garages are also nearby. Parking rates and hours of operation for these differ by location.
